

DARTMOOR NATIONAL PARK

Dartmoor National Park is a fabulous place for walking, cycling, horse riding and water sports. For keen walkers, there are a range of routes which offer fabulous views, and the opportunity to see the famous and popular Dartmoor ponies. For cyclists there is an extensive network of quiet lanes and designated cycle routes, together with over 350km of bridleways and byways. LAUNCESTON

Not far from Tavistock, you'll find the pretty town of Launceston, known as the "gateway to Cornwall". Apart from being a pleasant place to spend a day, shopping or having food in one of the many cafes or restaurants, there's plenty more to do as well. Launceston is home to a narrowgauge heritage railway, which runs as a tourist attraction during the summer months along a short rural route. For fans of history, the castle, built in circa 1070 is a popular place to visit and in wonderful condition for its age. You can even take a picnic in the grounds, and enjoy the wide reaching views of the surrounding countryside.





TAMAR VALLEY

The Tamar Valley lies on the border of Cornwall and Devon, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The valley is accessible by train on the scenic Tamar Valley Line, by boat on the Tamar Passenger Ferry from Plymouth, or by car. If you're traveling on foot there is an extensive network of local footpaths and walking routes that offer plenty of opportunities to explore this historic valley. Tamar Trails Centre is very popular, with 25km of walking trails and offering outdoor fun for all ages. Whether you enjoy hiking, cycling or kayaking, there truly is something for everyone.





PLYMOUTH

Under a 40 minute drive away from Little Orchard is Plymouth, a great location for shopping and eating out. Home to Drake Circus, there is a wealth of well-known shops, bars and restaurants as well as a cinema and the Theatre Royal - the perfect place for an action-packed day out. For those seeking a quieter day out, Drake's Island is the ideal spot to explore via a guided tour. Only accessible by boat, the island is home to amazing wildlife, including seals who like to nap on the rocks. Plymouth's charming old port, the Barbican is a great day out, and lined with specialist shops, art galleries, cafés and restaurants. It is also home to Plymouth Gin Distillery. Dating back to 1793, it is one of the oldest distilleries in the UK.

COMMUNITY

Tavistock is a bustling community with plenty of activities to choose from. The town is home to Tavistock Goose Fair, which is held every October. The fair has a long history, dating back to the early 12th century, and you can enjoy an open day of seeing cattle, sheep and Dartmoor ponies.

Each year, you can visit the town's Christmas Market hosted at Butchers Hall. There are plenty of stalls offering locally-made arts and crafts, festive food and drink and family-friendly activities.

Organised by Tavistock Lions Club, the annual Carnival week is hosted in the summer and packed full of events and activities for the whole family. The events include pavement art, music, dog show and the renowned 'mega quiz'!

For those who enjoy the great outdoors, Tavistock offers plenty of sporting opportunities to get involved with. The town boasts a rugby and football club, both of which welcome visitors to spectate. There is also a local Cricket Club which welcomes spectators and players.

GOLFING Opportunities

For the avid golfer there are a range of golfing opportunities close to Little Orchard. Tavistock Golf Club and Yelverton Golf Club are just a short drive away, with Yelverton known as a spectacular course, it offers outstanding views across Dartmoor and Cornwall and has been host to top quality competitions.





EDUCATION

Tavistock isn't short of educational opportunities, with Ofsted rated "Good" schools nearby. Just over half a mile away from Little Orchard is Tavistock Primary and Nursery School, catering to primaryaged and pre-schoolchildren. Tavistock College caters for secondary education and is just a short drive away. Mount Kelly, a leading boarding and day school, caters for children aged 3 to 18. Located on the edge of Dartmoor National Park, the school is highly regarded and has a track record of educating some of the finest swimmers in the country, with many going on to represent Great Britain in the Olympics. For those seeking Further Education, Plymouth University is just over 30 minutes away.

A SLICE OF HEAVEN

Tavistock is home to a wealth of eateries including Cornish Arms, whose chef competed on the Great British Menu. This Michelin Bib Gourmand restaurant offers great food using locally sourced produce and fantastic beer. The Whitchurch Inn is located just off Drakes Trail Cycle Route, half way between Tavistock and Plymouth, making it the perfect spot for some refreshments. The Horn of Plenty is nestled within the countryside and offers a gourmet dining experience, using local produce in its menu. For those with a sweet tooth, Flapjackery is located on the main high street and offers indulgent homemade fudge and flapjacks, using locally sourced ingredients including Westcountry clotted cream.
